He was part of the Elections Department of the OSCE Mission to Bosnia and Herzegovina, and has served in various international election observation missions as voter registration and electronic voting expert in France, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Venezuela and the Philippines. He has also worked as a consultant and expert in election related ICT projects in Albania, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and Iraq, as well as work for private sector technology companies in Austria, his natal country. Wolf is responsible for the Best Electoral System Test (BEST) tool and the ICTs in Elections Database, both available online. Wolf is the lead author of *Introducing Electronic Voting: Essential Considerations*, and contributor to *The Use of Open Source Technology in Elections and Certification of ICTs in Elections*.
